

Certification is now required by OSHA

As of November 2018, OSHA requires all crane operators to be certified to operate a crane. The acceptable ways of obtaining certification include: an accredited testing service, an independently audited employer program, military training, or by complying with qualifying state or local licensing requirements.

Runnion offers classes to help you prepare for exams

One week long local classes are now available, so you will be better prepared for the National Commission for Certification of Crane Operators (NCCCO) certification test. It includes three and a half days of classroom training and written testing, along with one and a half days of familiarization and practical testing on a crane provided by Runnion. There are two classes: one for knuckle boom operators and one for telescoping crane operators.

Passing NCCCO exams is the final step in certification

After passing the written and practical tests conducted by NCCCO, you will become a certified crane operator for the next five years and receive your NCCCO identification card.
